CHAPERONE/VOLUNTEER OVERVIEW

- May not bring preschoolers or children who are not registered at the school
- May not be left alone to supervise students
- Must be appropriately dressed at all times
- Must wear an identifying badge whenever serving as a volunteer
- Responsible for student safety among all else



CHAPERONE/VOLUNTEER OVERVIEW

- Must immediately report to someone in authority (teachers or administrator) any safety concerns or emergency issues relating to students
- Must follow the School Board Policy 3210-Standards of Ethical Conduct, School Board Policy 3210.01 – Code of Ethics and School Board Policy 3213 – Student Supervision and Welfare
- Must not discipline or inappropriately touch students



CHAPERONES

May not give students gifts, rewards, or food items of any kind without the teacher's/parent's permission

Must check attendance and know the whereabouts of students at all times

- Must be 21 years of age or older
- Overnight trips—must assume 24 hour-a-day responsibility ("on duty")
- Prohibited from sharing a room with students
- The administration supports the authority of the teachers.
- * All chaperones must follow the agenda set forth for the students remain with the group
- Please help us create a positive learning environment and set an appropriate example.

CHAPERONE'S RESPONSIBILITIES

Chaperones may not use their cell phone to conduct business and/or personal conversations while on the trip – with the exception of calling home in the evening.

*There will be no smoking and no alcohol will be consumed by any adult on this trip.

*We expect all of our students to be well-behaved and mannerly at all times.


If any issue arises, please contact the teacher immediately.

- No, please pack breakfast bars and snacks. We will stop at a rest stop and will only have access to vending machines.


